

**FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT
INVESTIGATIVE REPORT**

On April 3, 2014, Florida Department of Law Enforcement Special Agent Kristen Cortes was contacted by Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Eli Lawson who stated that Assistant Special Agent in Charge (ASAC) Keith Wilmer requested that SA Cortes write a report concerning an interview she was present during on February 22, 2014 of Adam Michael Frasch. This interview was conducted by Bay County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Sargent (Sgt.) Chad King at the BCSO at the request of the Leon County Sheriff's Office. SA Cortes was present during this interview.

Previously, on March 13, 2014 BCSO Sgt. Chad King documented this interview in BCSO report 2014-012100 refer to BCSO for report.

The following information was provided by Adam Frasch on February 22, 2014 at approximately 1815 hours.

Sgt. Chad King and SA Cortes entered the room at the BCSO where Adam Frasch(hereafter: Frasch) was waiting. Frasch wanted to know if his wife was okay. Sgt. King explained to Frasch that law enforcement officials needed to obtain some personal information for the children, his wife, and himself. Frasch provided Sgt. King with his family's personal information and addresses. Frasch stated that he had been living in Panama City, Florida on 4123 Nancee Drive in Panama City Beach, Florida due to him having a marital dispute with his wife Samira Frasch who resided at his other residence located at 8374 Inverness Drive in Tallahassee, Florida. Frasch had six (6) children total, and the two (2) babies, Hyrah M. Frasch and Skynnah M. Frasch he had with Samira. Frasch stated that he and his wife were working things out but if his wife became enraged, he came to Panama City to let her cool down. Sgt. King asked if they had any family in the area and Frasch stated that neither of them had family in Florida. Frasch's family resided in Nebraska and Samira was from Madagascar and her family lived in France.

Frasch stated that they had been trying to work things out recently. Two (2) or three (3) weeks ago his wife was pulled over for a traffic violation and the police officer called him to see if she was supposed to have the kids. They were black and she was so light skinned that the officer called Frasch to make sure it was alright for her to have the kids.

Sgt. King asked if there was any type of injunction or court order regarding the custody of their
