SEARCH WARRANT

IN THE COUNTY COURT
IN AND FOR BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA
IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA:

- TO: Sheriff Frank McKeithen and/or all Deputy Sheriffs of the Bay County Sheriff's Office
- TO: State Attorney Glenn Hess and/or all investigators of the Office of the State Attorney 14th Judicial Circuit
- TO: State Attorney William Meggs and/or all investigators of the Office of the State Attorney 2nd Judicial Circuit
- TO: Sheriff Robert Swearingen and/or all Deputy Sheriffs of the Leon County Sheriff's Office

WHEREAS, complaint on oath and in writing, supported by affidavit has this day been made before me, the undersigned Judge of the CIRCUIT Court, in and for 14th Judicial Circuit, Florida, by **Investigator James Nolan**. That Affiant has reason to believe and does believe certain evidence more particularly described herein below is being kept in or upon a certain premises, described as follows, to-wit:

From the intersection of Thomas Drive and Nancee Drive, travel southwest on Nancee Drive approximately 0.1 miles. 4123 Nancee Drive sits on the southeast side of the road and faces northwest. The residence is tan in color with white trim. It appears to be three stories tall. The numbers 4123 are clearly displayed in the trim of the garage door.

Being the property under the control of **Adam Frasch** and there is being kept on or in said premises certain evidence of a crime, to wit:

any and all cellular phones, computers or other electronic devices capable of storing, producing, sending or receiving electronic communication, any diaries, journals or written documentation related to Samira Frasch or Adam Frasch, any video or video recording devices, any digital medium capable of storing videos to include but not limited to thumb drives, compact discs or digital video discs that may contain evidence in violation of the laws of the State of Florida or is/are being kept and constitute(s) evidence of a violation of the laws of the State of Florida, to wit:

Murder contrary to 782.04 Florida Statute


And it appears to the Court that Affiant is a reputable citizen of Bay County, Florida, and that the facts set forth in said affidavit show and constitute probable cause for the issuance for this WARRANT and the Court being satisfied of the existence of said grounds in said application, or that there is probable cause to believe in their existence.

NOW, THEREFORE, you, or either of you, are hereby COMMANDED IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, in the daytime or in the night time, upon any day of the week, including Sunday, to enter the hereinbefore specified property (and the cartilage thereof) and to search therein for said evidence, and if the same, or any part thereof shall be found in said premises, then you are hereby authorized and commanded to seize said evidence and to bring it before this court or a court of competent jurisdiction and to arrest any person or persons found violating the law in connection with the same, and to bring them before the Honorable Court of competent jurisdiction to be dealt with according to law, and to forthwith make return of your doing in the person upon the execution of this warrant, which you are hereby ordered to execute within ten days of issuance, as provided by law.

YOU ARE FURTHER COMMANDED, in the event that you seize any of the said evidence hereinbefore described, to make up, at the time and place of seizure, a full and complete inventory of all things seized and taken, in person duplicate, signed by you, and to deliver one copy of said duplicate to the person named in the warrant, if said person is not present or should no person be named herein, then to some person in charge of, or living on the premises, and in the absence of such person, to leave the same on said premises.
